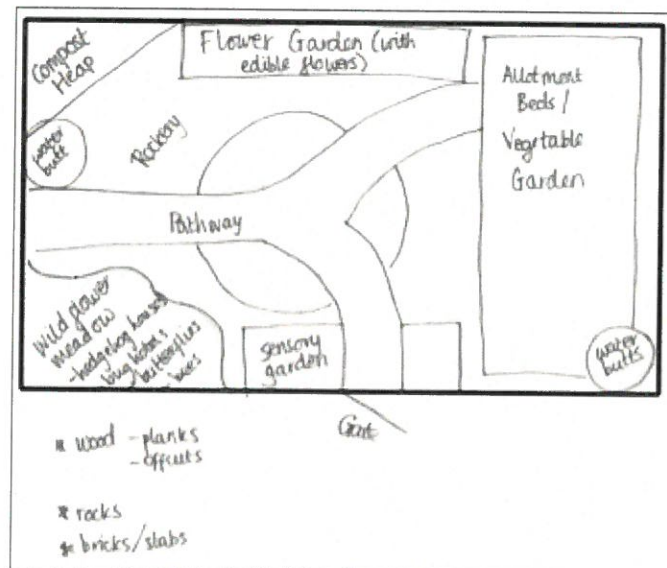




Eco School Garden
