Ice and Rice Activity

You will need:

Two ice cube trays (or fill one tray with half of each colour water), red and blue food colouring (if you want to make purple or any other colour you have), water, large tub and 1 cup of dry uncooked rice

Add the coloured ice cubes to the rice and explore! Adding different sized spoons and containers is always a hit!

How does it feel? Why are the ice cubes getting smaller? Why is the rice changing colour? What is happening? Why?
