All you need is chalk and some pieces of sponge/ cloth.



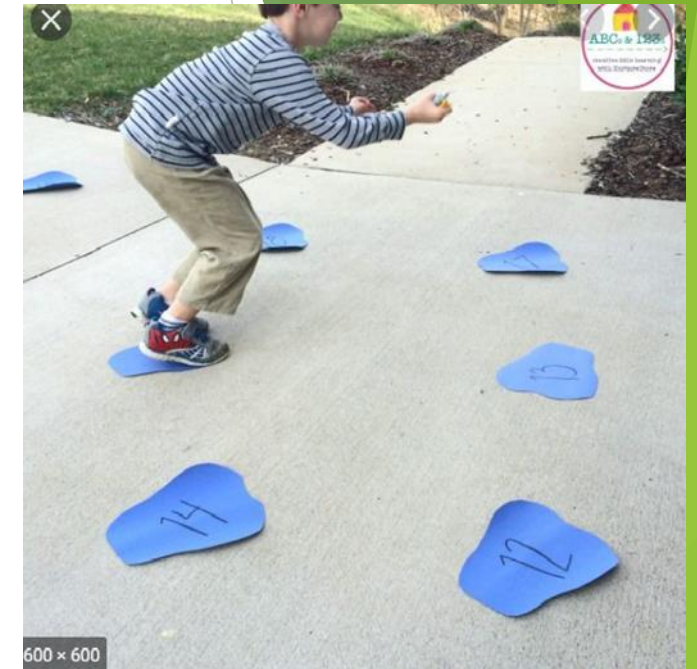
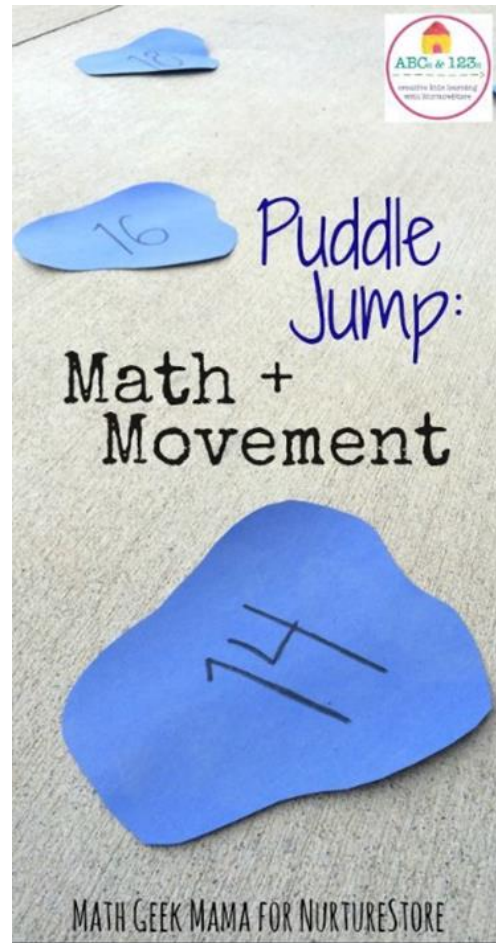
# Number splat!
