Dear Parents / Carers

We have welcomed back some of our Year N, Year R and Year 1 today; they have settled well back into their classrooms and it's lovely to see them in school again. Some Year 6 are also in, as well as the Key Worker's children; the schools are beginning to come alive again! We will do everything we can to support social distancing in school, and maintaining good hygiene habits, although cannot guarantee separation all the time.

We are now looking to opening up to Yr 2, 3, 4 and 5 from Monday 29 June. Again, we will do our best to support social distancing and personal hygiene but, again, cannot guarantee the children will stay apart all day.

Our principle is that **most** children will be in their classroom, with staff that they know, which we feel is the best way to settle them back into school. We are aiming for 2 days a week, for the last 3 weeks of term; however this is dependent on numbers. We will also aim to increase Yr N, R, 1 & 6 to 2 days a week for the final 3 weeks as well.

- Key worker children will be separate to class bubbles (due to the numbers of children wanting to return). Key worker children will NOT be able to also go into their classroom – however, I am looking into a way of integrating the Key Worker children into their classes, but this will be dependent on numbers and juggling keeping bubbles down to 15 so cannot make any promises at the moment.
- Children will need to bring their packed lunch, water and snack for the day.
- Children will have their work station in the classroom, where they will keep all their 'stuff' (lunch, coats, bags, pencil case etc).
- The school will be cleaned daily, and contact points during the day, to ensure the school is as clean as possible; with a deep clean taking place on a Wednesday when only Key Workers will be in.
- Doors and windows will be open as much as possible to ensure good ventilation
- Learning will be outside as much as possible
- Children will be expected to stay seated unless otherwise instructed. If children are finding the new way challenging or are not following the expectation, parents will be called to collect their child/ren.

RC and Nursery – Thursday and Friday

1S - Monday and Tuesday

1EY - Thursday and Friday

Year 2 – Monday and Tuesday (with Year 2 team)

Year 3 – Thursday and Friday

4K – Monday/Tuesday & Thursday/Friday

4H – Thursday and Friday

Year 5 – Monday and Tuesday

Year 6 - Monday/Tuesday & Thursday/Friday

These days have been provisionally allocated going by your initial responses.

We will then let parents know which day for your child to return next week. The days will be the same each week.

Bubbles will be set up on Wednesday 17 June, and we will not be able to add any more children after this.
