Science - We have enjoyed learning all about Magnets and their Forces. Now we have moved on to Rocks and Fossils and year 3 are big fans of rocks!


Topic - We started looking at the Ancient Mayan civilization and have studied how they lived, what they believed in and even sampled some of the food they have eaten.
