Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you all had a good break over Easter. The children have settled back into the school routines very well. The children (Yr 1- Yr 6) have sat some tests over the past couple of weeks. These are to help teachers know the strengths and gaps for the children in their class to target their teaching and target teaching assistants to support the children. Walking around the school there is a sense of calmness and purpose. We are finding that some children are finding the transition back into school more of a challenge than others, and the stamina for learning is gradually returning to previous levels. We have increased our Pastoral support across the school to support the children finding school more of a challenge at the moment. Following precision teaching and targeted support from teaching assistants, we will reassess the children again in June to check on their accelerated progress. We tested the children in February 2020, so have an accurate picture of where they were before the first lockdown which we are checking back to as well.

CHANGES FROM MONDAY 17 MAY

The school will take its next step towards the new normal. From Monday 17 May, we will revert back to the normal school start and end times as follows:

Nursery—8:50am-11:50am

Infants—8:45am—3:05pm

Juniors—8:55am—3:15pm

Children will line up in the playground as before.

We will move to school bubbles, meaning that we will have a normal lunchtime rota and the playground/field will be open to all the children.

We will also have school assemblies again.

If we do have a positive case, close contacts or the individual will be asked to self-isolate (the school will not necessarily close unless we have an outbreak). I will as always follow the advice given to me by Public Health England.

We will continue to keep the entrance and exits at both sites open to aid the flow of parents and children on and off the sites.
