A reminder that the school is closed on Monday 3rd May due to the Bank Holiday.

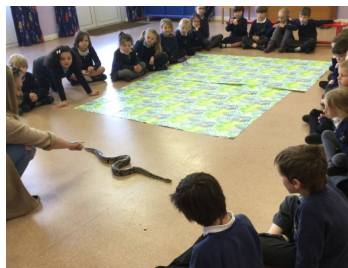
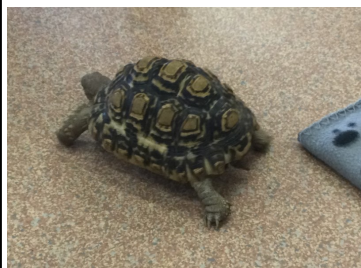
LIFTING RESTRICTIONS
